Chris Van Winkle • "Design & Composition"

Friday, Saturday and Sunday • March 19, 20, 21, 2010 • 9:30am-4:30pm



This 3-day workshop will cover design and composition, too often unaddressed in the workshop setting. The goal of the workshop will be for each participant to discover a strategy to be a composer, not just a reporter. Day one will focus on black and white value studies and the division of space. Exploration of color useage and it's power to evoke mood and emotion will be covered on the second day. Day three will give painters the opportunity to analyze one of their own unsuccessful paintings and then redesign and repaint it, using the knowledge gained during the first two days.

Chris Van Winkle, who is a California artist with roots in Canada, is an award-winning artist and signature member in both the National Watercolor Society and Watercolor West. His work has been featured in Watercolor Magazine where he was was selected as one of the "top twenty" art instructors.

For the past 21 years Chris has been teaching watercolor at Citrus College. He has conducted workshops in California, traveled and painted throughout the United States and Canada, and has led painting trips to Spain, Holland, Britain, Middle Europe and Russia.

Chris has served several years on the board of the National Watercolor Society, and as president for three years.
